


NEPTUNE

- named after the Roman god of the sea.
- 8th planet • farthest planet from sun
- 13 moons • "gas giants"
- Composed only of gas (Hydrogen (H)
Helium (He))
- first seen in 1846, its first moon was also spotted & named Triton.
- Triton is unusual moon since it orbits Neptune in opposite direction of Neptune's own rotation on its axis.
- large, water planet with a blue hydrogen-methane atmosphere & faint rings. (CH₄)

- Suffers the most violent weather in our Solar System.
- Storms have been spotted swirling around its surface & freezing winds that blow about 10x faster than hurricanes on Earth making it the windiest planet.
